

Additional COVID-19 Testing Resources

Due to the recent surge of COVID cases, it has become difficult to get tested. Knowing your status helps prevent transmission so we have put together a list of additional resources to obtain COVID-19 tests.

People who have symptoms of COVID-19 or have come into close contact with someone with COVID-19 should be tested at least 5 days after their exposure. It is recommended to have a COVID-19 rapid test kit on-hand for each household member. Every home in the U.S. is eligible to order 4 free at-home COVID-19 tests. The tests are free and usually ship in 7-12 days. [Order your tests now](#) so you have them when you need them.

Typically, grocery and drug stores, and Amazon, Wal-Mart, and Target carry these at-home test kits.
